**Requested Action:** The applicant requests he be granted a Regular Air Force (RegAF) Appointment as an exception to policy,


**Basis for Request:** The applicant is requesting the RegAF Appointment based on the fact he was recently advised that an audit found his Date of Separation (DOS) was erroneously established as June 2003 instead of September 1999. This erroneous update was made back in 1991. Further, he states that the 1999 DOS will render him ineligible for his in the promotion zone board consideration for colonel.

**Discussion:** Our office manages the Regular Air Force Appointment Program for all competitive categories and one of our responsibilities is to obtain presidential appointment and senate confirmation for those officers offered a Regular Air Force Appointment,

We have reviewed [REDACTED] application and AFPC/DPAMP (Physician Utilization Branch) advisory and based on the information provided we believe an injustice has occurred. Therefore, we concur with AFPC/DPAMP's recommendation that [REDACTED]'s request for an Exception to Policy for a RegAF Appointment be granted.

**Recommendation:** We concur with AFPC/DPAMP's advisory and recommend approval of [REDACTED]'s request. In addition, we suggest the AFBCMR

SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records (DD Form 149)

1. Request for grant of Regular Air Force status.
2. DPAMP notified [REDACTED] of an erroneous date of separation 25 June 98 and the action taken to curtail the separation date to 30 Sept 99.
3. Seven years ago Career Reserve Status was granted with a 2003 date of separation. A recent audit identified the separation date as erroneously established upon total commissioned service rather than total active service so the separation date was rolled back to 30 Sept 99. The resulting date is equal to 20 years total active federal service. The procedure for assumption of Regular status for the medical corps changed from an application process in Jan 97 to an offer at the time of selection for promotion. [REDACTED] will be denied consideration for O6 selection in the zone because of the revised date, therefore he lacks the opportunity to assume Regular status without recourse to AFBCMR.
4. The AFMC/SG strongly endorses relief by granting Regular Air Force.
5. Based on the unique circumstances of [REDACTED] and the attached justification, it is recommended that [REDACTED] be awarded Regular status.
