SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records - [REDACTED]

Requested Action and Basis for Request. Restore 5 days charged leave 3 - 7 Aug 98. Applicant states he was on house hunting PTDY when he signed in on 10 Aug 98.

Facts and Discussion. Applicant signed the travel voucher on 10 Aug 98. Therefore, it shows allowable travel 8 - 9 Aug 98 and charged leave 3 - 7 Aug 98. However, travel voucher shows applicant arrived on 4 Aug 98 and leave form shows approved PTDY 5 - 12 Aug 98. We find applicant was present for duty on 5 Aug 98 and unit commander approved 8 days PTDY starting 5 Aug 98. In this case, we support granting relief because applicant arrived on 4 Aug 98 and finance erroneously took the date applicant signed the travel voucher as the date he signed in at the unit.

Recommendation. Approve restoring 5 days to current leave account.
