Under the authority of Section 1552, Title 10, United States Code and AFI 36-2603, and having assured compliance with the provisions of the above regulation, the decision of the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records is announced, and it is directed that:

1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished administratively at this headquarters.
2. The applicant is requesting [REDACTED] bad year of service in 1996 be changed to a good year of service [REDACTED].
3. The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding this case:
 - a. The applicant was authorized for annual training from 18 to 29 March 1996.
 - b. While training on 22 March 1996, the applicant received notice of [REDACTED] sister's death, and was released from training.
 - c. The applicant rescheduled and completed [REDACTED] annual training from 17 to 23 June 1996.
 - d. Due to the incompleteness of [REDACTED] annual training from 18 to 29 March 1996, the applicant's retention/retirement (R/R) year for 17 June 1995 to 16 June 1996 was unsatisfactory.
4. Recommend this application be approved. Circumstances beyond the applicant's control caused [REDACTED] annual training to be cut short resulting in an unsatisfactory year of service. As shown by [REDACTED] selection as the Noncommissioned Officer of the Quarter, and the reference from one of [REDACTED] troops, the applicant has presented a positive dedication to the Reserve program. [REDACTED] influence as a hands-on supervisor has proven to be a great motivation to [REDACTED] work force. In order to correct the applicant's record, the board would have to award 5 non-paid inactive duty training points for R/R year 17 June 1995 to 16 June 1996.
5. If this application is disapproved, no further action is necessary.
