

SUBJECT: Application for Correction of Military Records - [REDACTED]

Requested Action and Basis for Request. Restore **12** days lost at FY98 year-end balancing. Applicant states mission requirements prevented him **from** using these days.

Facts and Discussion. Applicant had 60 days on 1 Oct **97**, used **18** day, and had **72** days on **30** Sep **98**. He lost **12** days on 1 Oct **98** because under **10** USC **701** members cannot carry more than 60 days into the next FY. The applicant states he lost **12** days because deployment to [REDACTED] from 2 Sep to 4 Oct 98 prevented him **from** using these days before 1 Oct. Applicant's commander supports restoring lost leave since applicant was notified on or about 28 Aug **98** to deploy to [REDACTED] AFB [REDACTED]. In this case, we support granting relief because applicant **was** unable to take leave due to military requirements.

Recommendation. Approve restoring **12** days to current leave account.
