1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to a zone "A" Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) with an award level of 1.0 for the OS rating.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Pfeiffer, Mr. Beckett, and Mr. Dunn, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 October 2006 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 8/9 July 2004, vice 31 May/1 June 2006. The term is 4 years.

b. The 12/1/10 month NAVPERS 1070/621 extension agreements, operative on or about 13 July 2005, 13 August 2005, and 13 June 2006, are null and void.

c. The 12 month NAVPERS 1070/621 extension agreement the petitioner executed to meet obligated service for BUPERS order 1106 will establish an SEAOS of 8 July 2009.

d. The above changes will entitle petitioner to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.0 for the OS rating.

e. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


