1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show Petitioner is entitled to Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) for designated location of dependents.

2. The Board, consisting of Messrs. George, Pfeiffer, and Zsalmán, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 24 November 2008 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:


a. Petitioner is authorized BAH for designated location of dependents for the period 13 November 2007 to 21 December 2007. Address for dependents is [REDACTED]

b. That part of Petitioner's request for continued payment for BAH for the Jacksonville, FL area is denied. In accordance with the Joint Federal Travel Regulation, chapter 10, BAH is based on the assigned duty station and the Petitioner is assigned to SWFLANT, Kings Bay, GA.

c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
