

RECOMMENDATION:


That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. On 16 December 2008 Petitioner submitted a letter to the appropriate naval authorities requesting an extension of the 180-day period in which to ship HHG at government expense incident to his discharge on 30 June 2008. On 16 December 2008 the appropriate naval authorities approved his request for an extension for an additional period expiring on 25 June 2009.

b. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


