

RECOMMENDATION:


That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. She was enlisted in paygrade E-2, vice E-1, effective 28 July 2008 (Active Duty Service Date). She was further advanced to paygrade E-3 effective 16 May 2009. She met the criteria for advanced pay grade based on the DEP Referral program. (NOTE: The change in the effective date of advancement to E-3 may also impact on Petitioner's E-4 advancement opportunity. If Petitioner was eligible for the E-4 examination but did not take it because the above change had not been made, the following procedures will apply. Petitioner should take the next available E-4 advancement examination and compare the Final Multiple Score (FMS) received on that examination with the FMS that was required for the "missed" examination. A command endorsement/recommendation and a copy of this letter must be included. The Board will determine whether the request will be approved.)

b. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
