1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was authorized shipment of his household goods (HHG) from his last duty station to his Home of Record in West Bend, Wisconsin on 30 June 2009.

2. The Board, consisting of Messers. Pfeiffer, Exnicios, and George, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 4 June 2010 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. Petitioner is authorized standard reimbursement using the normal and accepted method of calculation for Petitioner's personal property move to West Bend, Wisconsin on or about 30 June 2009.

b. Petitioner received separation orders prior to the start of his HHG move on 30 June 2009.

c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

NOTE: You are advised to resubmit your entire personal property move claim. The claim package must include this letter authorizing the reimbursement, a copy of the Petitioner's separation orders with valid Line of Accounting, weight tickets, completed DD 1351-2 and receipts for all legitimate HHG moving expenses. The entire package should be mailed to: Business Support Department (FISCN), HHG Audit Team Division, Code 302, 1968 Gilbert Street STE 600, Norfolk, VA 23511-3392. 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
