1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show he reenlisted USN vice USNR.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Pfeiffer, Mr. Zsalman, and Mr. George, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 31 January 2011 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), executed on or about 8 April 2003 is USN, vice USNR, and RADO MONTHS/DAYS 000/000, vice 036/000

b. The 12 month agreement to remain on active duty (NAVPERS 1070/622), executed on or about 21 April 2005, is null and void.

c. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), executed on or about 10 February 2006 is USN, vice USNR, and RADO MONTHS/DAYS 000/000, vice 072/000. The Enlistment Master File (EMF) should reflect BRCL "11", SPI-TAR "blank", TAR-TEMAC "blank", EAOS "9 February 2012", RADOMO "000", and EREN "blank".


d. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621), executed on or about 16 October 2010 is USN, vice USNR. This will establish an EOS "9 February 2012", and SEEOS "9 November 2012"

e. The 9 month agreement to recall or extend active duty (NAVPERS 1070/622), executed on or about 18 October 2010, is null and void.

f. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
