1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show restoration of annual leave.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Pfeiffer, Mr. Zsalmán, and Mr. George, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 1 August 2011 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The member was in a full duty status vice Permissive Temporary Additional Duty or annual leave for the following periods:

20 Nov 07 to 30 Nov 07 (11)
10 Dec 07 to 25 Dec 07 (16)
29 Dec 07 to 30 Dec 07 (02)
03 Jan 08 to 05 Jan 08 (03)
19 Jan 08 to 22 Jan 08 (04)
24 Jan 08 to 27 Jan 08 (04)
03 Feb 08 to 03 Feb 08 (01)
01 Mar 08 to 04 Mar 08 (04)
07 Mar 08 to 17 Mar 08 (11)
25 Mar 08 to 27 Mar 08 (03)
29 Mar 08 to 06 Apr 08 (09)
24 Apr 08 to 27 Apr 08 (04)
08 May 08 to 14 May 08 (07)

b. Note: As a result of this change, the Petitioner will be credited with 79 days of leave not taken that were previously charged to the member's account on or about 6 June 2008.

c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
