1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show that Subject enrolled in the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) for spousal category of coverage prior to his retirement on 5 January 1985.

2. The Board, consisting of Messrs. Zsalman, Ruskin and George, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 May 2014 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.


RECOMMENDATION:

That Subject's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, as follows:

- a. Prior to Subject's transfer to the Fleet Reserve List on 5 January 1985, he enrolled in SBP for spouse coverage, at the full base amount, naming his spouse [REDACTED] as the sole beneficiary.
- b. [REDACTED]
- c. SBP costs that would have been deducted from Subject's retired pay will be deducted from Petitioner's benefits. No annuity will be paid to Petitioner until all unpaid costs have been reimbursed. No waiver of premiums is authorized.
- d. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Subject's naval record.


