1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to add the Loan Repayment Program (LRP) to his enlistment guarantees. Petitioner also requests a personal appearance before the Board.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Zsalman, Mr. George, and Mr. Ruskin, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 April 2014 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board

finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. Option (2) of Annex \_ to the DD Form 4 reflects "Loan Repayment Program (LRP) up to \$65,000", vice "N/A". All other enlistment guarantees remain the same.


b. This change allows Petitioner to apply for benefits under LRP. However, final determination of eligibility cannot be made until Petitioner submits the required LRP documentation. A copy of this letter, the corrected Annex (NAVCRUIT 1133/52), and initial LRP application information should be provided to the LRP desk. Information, and an example of an LRP application, can be found at [cnrc.navy.mil](http://cnrc.navy.mil), select incentives, then frequently asked questions. c. The Board members also considered Petitioner's request for a personal appearance; however, the Board found that the issues in the case were adequately documented and that a personal appearance would not materially add to the Board's understanding of the issues involved. Thus, Petitioner's request for a personal appearance has been denied.

d. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.


