1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Petitioner filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show that he had sufficient qualifying years for a Reserve retirement vice being discharged.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 December 2014 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, as follows:

a. PERS-912 is directed to move 38 correspondence course points from the anniversary year ending 25 February 1977 to the anniversary year ending 25 February 1976.


b. Petitioner will be transferred to the Retire Reserve List without pay, effective 1 September 1991, with 20 years of qualifying service.

c. PERS-912 is directed to update all record management systems to reflect the change in Petitioner's status as a member of the Retired Reserve.

d. PERS-912 is directed to assist Petitioner with completing an application for retire pay at age 60.

e. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


