Regarding the names and votes of Board members who considered your case, be advised that on 4 November 2009, Mr. Boyd, Ms. Ballinger, and Ms. Henkel considered your case, Docket No. 431-09, and unanimously denied your request. On 2 December 2014, Ms. Aldrich, Ms. McCain, and Mr. Spain considered your case, Docket No. 7637-14 and also reconsidered your previous case, Docket No. 431-09, however, your request was again unanimously denied. In this regard, in the absence of sufficient material evidence for reconsideration, the decision of the Board is final, and your only recourse would be to initiate action, at no cost to the Board, to a court of appropriate jurisdiction.
