This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to the provisions of title 10 of the United States Code, section 1552.

A three member panel of the Board for Correction of Naval Records, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 15 December 2014. After careful consideration of your application, the Board concluded that your application was not timely filed, and that it would not be in the interest of justice to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Although you claim that you had the "cutting score" (points) to be promoted the E-5 effective 1 September 1987, you in fact, did not have a high enough cutting score to advance in September 1987, see enclosure (1). Therefore, the Board did not believe it was in the interest of equity or fairness to grant your request.

You may request reconsideration of this decision within one year from the date of the Board's decision. However, your request must include newly discovered relevant evidence which was not reasonably available to you when you submitted your application. Further, the evidence must pertain to the timeliness of your application or to its merits. Absent such additional evidence, further review of your application is not possible.
