1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to correct orders from Permanent Change of Station (PCS) Orders to Active Duty for Training (ADT) Orders.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Exnicios, Mr. Ivins and Mr. Spain, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 30 October 2014 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION


Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action:

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. Prior to authorizing the Active Duty for Training (ADT) orders written on or about 23 December 2013, a waiver to exceed 180 days was submitted and approved by the cognizant authority.
- b. The Petitioner executed ADT vice Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders dated 23 December 2013 on 14 January 2014. Note: All other remarks remain the same.
- c. Orders authorize lodging, per diem and rental car (personal conveyance) expenses from 14 Jan 2014 - 14 Feb 2014, dates prior to embarking on the USS George Bush CVN 77.
- d. Petitioner is authorized Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) with dependents at the Military Housing Area (MHA) Stockton, CA, 95206 rate, the place from which called to Active Duty (PLEAD) from 14 January 2014 to the end of the orders.
- e. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
