- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show timely written request to elect spouse coverage under the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) within one year of the marriage and that Petitioner had no eligible SBP beneficiaries at the time of retirement.
- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 February 2016 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows: before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. At the time of her 30 November 2006 transfer to the Fleet Reserve, Petitioner did not have any eligible SBP beneficiaries.
- b. The Petitioner elected Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) full spouse coverage, naming , within one year of the date of her marriage (which occurred on 12 December 2014). Any other election or declination executed by Petitioner is null and void.
- c. Petitioner is responsible for unpaid SBP costs that would have been deducted beginning the first day of the thirteenth month following her marriage to _______. No waiver of unpaid premiums will be granted.
- d. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
- 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled mapter.

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5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
