1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show timely written request to decline spouse coverage under the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) within one year of the marriage.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 11 August 2016 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds that before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The Petitioner declined Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) full spouse coverage, naming [REDACTED] within one year of the date of his marriage (which occurred on 29 December 2013). Any other election or declination executed by Petitioner is null and void. Note: Petitioner suspended SBP full spouse coverage, naming [REDACTED] on the date following her death (which occurred on 3 September 2012).


b. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
