- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show timely written request for conversion from spouse to former spouse coverage under the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP).
- 2. The Board, consisting of reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 Jun 2016 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows: before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

## RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. Prior to his 31 October 2008 transfer to the Fleet Reserve he enrolled in SBP for spouse coverage, at the full base amount, naming as the beneficiary. Any other election or declination executed by Petitioner is null and void.
- b. The Petitioner changed his Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) coverage from spouse to former spouse SBP coverage naming as the beneficiary, at the same level of coverage as previously elected, within one year of the date of his divorce (which was finalized on 11 September 2012). Any other election or declination executed by the Petitioner is null and void.
  - c. This is in compliance with a court order.
  - d. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
- 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
