1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to receive entitlement for Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 29 September 2016 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds that before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. Petitioner was authorized without dependents rate BAH for the Military Housing Area [REDACTED] area from 21 July 2015 to 10 March 2016. Note: Petitioner enlisted in the Naval Reserve on 19 November 2014 for 8 years. Furthermore, he entered active service for training via the Naval Reserve on 21 July 2015. Finally, he was released from active service on 10 March 2016.

b. Note: per the Joint Training Regulation (JTR); if a member is in the accession pipeline between initial Temporary Duty (TDY) and initial permanent duty station (PDS). A Reserve Component (RC) member is authorized BAH/OHA based on the primary residence location at the time called/ordered to active duty while attending accession training.

c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
