	The Petitioner elected Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) child coverage naming and within one year of the date of the birth (which occurred or Note: Petitioner is enrolled in spouse SBP coverage, which will not be effected by cord change.

- b. Petitioner is responsible for unpaid SBP costs that would have been deducted upon the election of child coverage. No waiver of unpaid premiums will be granted.
 - c. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
