1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Petitioner, an enlisted member of the Marine Corps, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting removal of an Administrative Remarks entry (6105) counseling dated 1 June 2016 from his Official Military Personnel File (OMPF).

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 30 June 2017 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that partial corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of enclosures (1) through (6), naval records and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Petitioner received an Administrative Remarks (6105) counseling entry dated 1 June 2016 for a failure to pass his Physical Fitness Test (PFT) on 31 May 2016. See enclosure (3).

c. Petitioner's Commanding Officer provided a letter to the Board for Correction of Naval Records requesting to have the entry removed. See enclosure (4). He states, in part, that the PFT ran on 31 May 2016 was not ran for an official score.

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CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board decided to remove the Administrative Remarks (6105) counseling entry dated 1 June 2016. In this regard, the Board determined that the Petitioner's Commanding Officer letter merits favorable consideration since the PFT was ran for an inventory score rather than for official purpose.

In view of the above, the Board directs the following partial corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION

Petitioner's naval record be corrected by removing Administrative Remarks entry dated 15 August 2013, from Petitioner's OMPF.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
