- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting his naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to Zone "A" Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).
- 2. The Board, consisting of and and reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 June 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. On 9 July 2015, Petitioner enlisted in the Naval Reserve for a term of 8 years, of which 4-years is considered and active duty obligation.
- b. On 23 Febraury 2016, Petitioner entered active duty and signed NAVPERS 1070/621, Agreement to Extend Enlistment for a term of 24-months.
- c. On 2 January 2020, Career Waypoint notification letter was issued to Petitioner with reenlistment authorization until the end of April 2021.
- d. On 23 January 2020, Petitioner's Commanding Officer approved his request to reenlist on 22 February 2020 for term of 6-years.

- e. On 23 February 2020, Petitioner's extension became operative.
- f. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. In accordance with reference (b), Petitioner was authorized to reenlist on 22 February 2020 for a term of 4-years for a Zone "A" SRB. However, Petitioner's Command was unable to get the reenlistment processed in a timely manner, resulting in his extension becoming operative and voiding his ability to receive the SRB. The Board felt that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitiner reenlisted on 22 February 2020 for a term of 6-years. Note: Petitioner's 23 February 2020 for a term of 24-months was discountinued.

This change will entitle the Petitioner to a Tier Three, Zone "A" SRB with an award level of 1.0 (\$45,000 award ceiling) for the Interior Communications Electrician (IC) rating.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
