- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's end of active obligated service (EAOS) is 24 April 2021 vice 24 April 2022.
- 2. The Board, consisting of allegations, and allegations, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 July 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. In accordance with reference (b), all new PACT [Professional Apprenticeship Career Track] Program contracts written after 31 March 2018 until further notice will be for an active duty period of three years verse four years. This will be annotated on the DD Form 4 as an Active Component enlistment and annotated as three years on the NA VCRUIT Form 1 133/53, PACT Program Enlistment Annex.
- c. On 10 April 2018, Petitioner enlisted for 8 years in the U.S. Naval Reserve. Furthermore, Petitioner signed an Enlistment Guarantees (NAVCRUIT 1133/53) with the following option: Engineering/Fireman PACT Program Guarantee for an active duty period of 3 years.

- d. On 25 April 2018, Petitioner entered active duty with an end of active obligated service (EAOS) of 24 April 2021.
- e. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that an error existed in Petitioner's Enlistment/Reenlistment Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4/1), in accordance with reference (b), her contract should have been for 3 years.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The enlistment/reenlistment document (DD Form 4/1) executed on 10 April 2018 was for a term of 3 years vice 4 years. Note: This will establish an EAOS of 24 April 2021.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
