1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish entitlement to Special Duty Assignment Pay (SDAP) for the period of 1 July 2017 through 30 September 2017.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 June 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. Petitioner earned the Submarine Nuclear Propulsion Plant Operator – Electrical Navy Enlisted Classification (NEC) code 3354/N14O on 1 May 2017.

b. Petitioner reported to [REDACTED] in a duty status on 28 June 2017.

c. Petitioner's SDAP was started effective 1 October 2020.

d. On 4 January 2021, Commanding Officer, [REDACTED] certified Petitioner was eligible to receive SDAP from 1 July 2017 through 30 September 2017.

e. On 28 April 2021, Petitioner released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve.

f. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. Petitioner was eligible for SDAP entitlement while serving as Submarine Nuclear Propulsion Plant Operator – Electrical onboard [REDACTED]. However, Petitioner's command failed to submit SDAP certification in a timely manner resulting in the SDAP entitlement not being processed.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was entitled to SDAP while assigned as Submarine Nuclear Propulsion Plant Operator Electrical (NEC 3354/N140), onboard [REDACTED] during the period of 1 July 2017 through 30 September 2017, at SDAP level SD-5 at the rate of \$375.00 per month. Note: Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine if Petitioner is due retroactive incentive.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
