1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's current reenlistment contract reflects inactive status vice active.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 October 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 27 March 2013, Petitioner enlisted for 8 years in the U.S. Naval Reserve with an expiration of obligated service (EOS) of 26 March 2021.

c. On 18 June 2013, Petitioner entered active duty, and was honorably released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve upon completion of required active service on 25 October 2013.

d. On 26 May 2017, Petitioner was mobilized in support of Operation Counter Terrorism under Title 10, section 12302, and was honorably released from active duty and transferred to the Navy Reserve upon completion of required active service on 3 August 2018.

e. On 12 May 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years in the U.S. Naval Reserve with an erroneous status of "Active" vice "Inactive" and reserve active duty obligation (RADO) months/days of "072/000" vice "000/000".

f. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

g. On 31 March 2021, COMNAVPERSCOM notified command that this message authorized and extended temporary active duty of Petitioner to a new end of active obligated service (EAOS). PSD was directed to extend Petitioner to 26 September 2022 as authorized by COMNAVPERSCOM.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that due to administrative error, Petitioner's reenlistment contract was marked as "active" rather than "inactive". Petitioner was erroneously considered as Full Time Support.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 6-year immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) executed on 12 May 2020 listed status: "Inactive" vice "Active".

Note: Petitioner's RADO and special program indicator may require updating that is appropriate to Petitioner's current status.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
