1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to reflect Home of Record (HOR) as █ vice █.

2. The Board reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 10 December 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of enclosures (1) through (13), relevant portions of Petitioner's naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. In accordance with reference (b), correction to the HOR may be authorized when, there is a bona fide error with the place originally named at time of current entry into the Service was not in fact the actual home or a break in service that exceeds one full day.

b. On 19 March 1995, Petitioner earned an Associated in Science Degree from College of [REDACTED]. Petitioner's address on transcript reflect [REDACTED]. See enclosure (2).

c. On 19 June 1998, Petitioner earned Bachelor of Science Degree from [REDACTED] University, [REDACTED]. See enclosure (3).

d. Petitioner's Report of Medical Examination dated 10 September 1999 reflects: Block 11 (Organization Unit) Navy Recruiting District (NRD) [REDACTED]; Block 13 (Place of Birth) [REDACTED]; and Block 15 (Examining Facility or Examiner and Address) [REDACTED] Medical Clinic, [REDACTED]. See enclosure (4).

e. Petitioner's Report of Medical History dated 10 September 1999 reflects: Block 3 (Home Address) [REDACTED] and Block 7 (Examining Facility or Examiner and Address) Branch Medical Clinic, [REDACTED]. See enclosure (5).

f. On 17 December 1999, Petitioner signed NAVCRUIT 1000/20, Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office with address annotated as [REDACTED]. See enclosure (6).

g. On 11 June 2005, Petitioner received Doctor of Medicine Diploma from [REDACTED] University, [REDACTED]. See enclosure (7)

h. On 17 June 2005, Petitioner signed NAVPERS 1000/4, Officer Appointment Acceptance and Oath of Office with address annotated as [REDACTED] and Petitioner's Member Data Summary dated 18 October 2021 reflects HOR as [REDACTED].” See enclosures (8-9).

i. Petitioner was assigned to [REDACTED] Emergency Medical Facilities Detachment, [REDACTED] from 13 July 2012 to 4 December 2012 and Naval Hospital [REDACTED] from 4 December 2012 through 28 June 2016. See enclosure (10).

j. On 6 September 2013, NAVPERS 1070/74, Report of Home of Record and Place from Which Ordered to Active Duty is signed by Certifying Officer, indicating Petitioner's HOR as [REDACTED]” and Date of Entry on Active Duty as “July 1, 2005”; Signature of Member block reflects Petitioner's name typed in but was not signed. See enclosure (11)

k. On 29 March 2021, Navy Personnel Command (PERS-312) provided an unfavorable advisory opinion to enclosure (1). PERS-312 recommended disapproval of relief based Petitioner signing enclosure (11) [NAVPERS 1070/74, Report of Home of Record and Place from Which Ordered to Active Duty]. See enclosure (12).

l. On 2 June 2021, Petitioner was provided a copy of PERS-312 advisory opinion for an opportunity to provide additional documentation or statement; a rebuttal was not received. See enclosure (13).

BOARD CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and despite the contents of enclosure (12), the Board unanimously concluded Petitioner's request warrants favorable corrective action. In this regard, the Board concluded Petitioner met the basic eligibility criteria to elect [REDACTED] as HOR upon entry on active duty. However, Petitioner's official military personnel file does not contain a signed copy of her initial HOR election via NAVPERS 1070/74, Report of Home of Record and Place from Which Ordered to Active Duty. The Board determined Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect her entry onto active duty from [REDACTED] vice [REDACTED]; therefore, under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

BOARD RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's HOR upon entry on active duty on 17 June 2005 was [REDACTED]" vice "[REDACTED]"

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
