

However, the Board concluded that you were required to agree to a 6-year term of enlistment in order to receive the receive the \$5,000 Infantry Leadership Option bonus. Furthermore, the Board concluded that you received the bonus effective 2 September 2020. Because no breach of contract by the Marine Corps occurred, you are required to serve 6 years. In this connection, the Board substantially concurred with the comments contained in the advisory opinion.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
