- e. Petitioner transferred to the Retired Reserve without pay effective 1 July 2001.
- f. Petitioner transferred to the Retired Reserve with pay effective RCSBP and Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) Spouse and Children premium deductions began.
- g. On 1 July 2013, SBP coverage changes to Spouse only as Petitioner's youngest child ages out.
- h. Petitioner divorced on 10 June 2016. Divorce decree directs former spouse to receive percentage of Petitioner's Navy pension should he pass away before her.

BOARD CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect his desire to elect his former spouse as his RCSPB/SBP beneficiary. Although Petitioner did not complete the proper administrative requirements, the Board felt that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

BOARD RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner elected to change RCSBP/SBP coverage from "Spouse" to "Former Spouse" naming as the beneficiary, at the same level of coverage as previously elected within 1-year of divorce on 10 June 2016.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
