1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) effective 16 August 1990 block 12 (Record of service) cover the period of 8 August 1985 to 16 August 1990.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 29 June 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 15 November 1980, Petitioner enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve for 6 years with an EOS of 14 November 1986.

c. 15 January 1981, Petitioner entered active duty in the U.S. Marine Corps for 4 years, and was transferred to the Marine Corps Reserve 14 January 1985. Petitioner completed 4 years of active service.

d. On 18 June 1985, Petitioner reenlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps for 3 years. Petitioner's DD Form 1966 (Application for enlistment – Armed forces of the U.S.) listed a projected active duty date of 8 August 1985 and date of enlistment of 8 August 1985.

e. On 15 June 1988, Petitioner reenlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps for 2 years. Petitioner completed 2 years, 10 months, and 7 days.

f. On 9 July 1990, Petitioner's request for an agreement to extend enlistment for was approved by HQMC for 1 month.

g. On 16 August 1990, Petitioner was released from active duty. Petitioner completed 2 years, 2 months, and 2 days. Furthermore, Petitioner was issued a DD Form 215 (Correction to DD Form 214, Certificate of release or discharge from active duty) listing corrections to block 12b and 12d to DD Form 214 issued on 14 August 1990.

h. On 17 August 1990, Petitioner reenlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve for 2 years.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of reference (b), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner completed the following periods of service: 15 November 1980 to 14 January 1981 (U.S. Marine Corps Reserve); 15 January 1981 to 14 January 1985 (U.S. Marine Corps); 15 January 1985 to 7 August 1985 (U.S. Marine Corps Reserve); 8 August 1985 to 16 August 1990 (U.S. Marine Corps). Furthermore, during the 1980s, it was policy that a DD Form 214 be issued when a service member reenlisted. It was discovered that a DD Form 214 was missing for the period of 8 August 1985 to 14 June 1988. Additionally, the DD Form 214 issued with an effective date of 16 August 1990 had errors in block 12.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was issued a DD Form 214 for the period of active duty from 8 August 1985 to 14 June 1988.

Petitioner's DD Form 214 issued with an effective date of 16 August 1990 requires that block 12c, block 12d, and block 12e be verified and corrected.

That part of the Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing be denied. DD 214 is prepared to cover periods of service on active duty. All entries relate only to the current period of active duty unless otherwise noted.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
