



In your petition, you have requested that the Board review the decision of the CORB. You contend that you would like to continue to serve for 20 years and that you are fit for duty and deployment. In support of your petition, you have provided a copy of a physical readiness test score sheet and associated documents dated 20 January 2021 as well as a report of medical examination.

The Board carefully reviewed the entirety of your petition and its attachments, the documents relating to your evaluation by the FPEB, and its findings, including its attachments and the materials that you had previously submitted, as well as the PFR decision by CORB. After thoughtful consideration of the entirety of these materials and your contentions, the Board was unable to find an error or injustice resulting from the process that you were afforded or the evidence that was presented at each stage of the prior proceedings. In reaching its decision, the Board considered the material that you provided with your petition, but found that this material did not outweigh the findings of the prior proceedings. Accordingly, the Board was constrained to deny your petition.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
