1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Retention Bonus (SRB) for \$11,500 and an Early Reenlistment Kicker.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 9 November 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 28 May 2013, Petitioner entered active duty.

c. On 21 October 2016, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Current Contract (ECC) of 20 October 2020.

d. In accordance with reference (b), this bulletin announces the SRB program and the BROKEN SERVICE SRB (BSSRB) program authorized for FY21. With the advent of several new SRB programs, Marines are encouraged to thoroughly review the contents of this bulletin. First term Marines (Zone A) and career Marines (Zone B, C, D, and E) who reenlist on or after 7

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July 2020 are eligible for the FY21 SRB program. This will include any regular component first term or career Marine with an ECC from 1 October 2020 to 30 September 2021.

Marines in Zones A, B, and C who submit for a 48 month reenlistment between 7 July 2020 through 30 September 2020 with a Primary Military Occupational Specialties (PMOS) that is listed in section(s) 3.l, 3.m, and 3.n, and are subsequently approved, will rate an 8,000 dollar Early Reenlistment Kicker in addition to the PMOS bonus amount listed in section(s) 3.l, 3.m, and 3.n. After 30 September 2020, this Early Reenlistment Kicker will expire. (1) Example in dollars: An FY20 Zone A Cpl submits for reenlistment into PMOS 0311 on 8 August 2020 for 48 months and is approved.

Zone B applies to those active component Marines with 6 to 10 years of active military service. Zone B PMOS bonus payments for Marines who reenlist for at least 48 months obligated service are authorized as listed below in dollars (bonuses for Marines who reenlist for 36 to 47 months obligated service will be calculated as per para 3.i). Furthermore, a zone "B" SRB for MOS 0481, which is capped at \$11,250 for 48 months of additional obligated service was authorized.

- e. On 1 July 2020, Petitioner was promoted to Staff Sergeant/E-6.
- f. On 30 July 2020, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted and HQMC approved on 13 August 2020.
- g. On 17 August 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an ECC of 16 August 2024 and received a prorated SRB.
- h. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following partial corrective action. The Board concluded that Marines must gain a minimum of 48 months of additional obligated service to get the full SRB and Early Reenlistment Kicker. Due to no fault of Petitioner, his original reenlistment was not properly annotated to reflect the required months in order to receive the full SRB and the Early Reenlistment Kicker, which resulted in him only receiving a portion of the SRB and not receiving the ERK. Furthermore, the Board concluded that the SRB amount Petitioner is eligible for is \$11,250 vice the \$11,500 he requested.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The enlistment/reenlistment document (DD Form 4), executed on 17 August 2020 is for a term of 4 years and 3 months, vice 4 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "B" SRB for MOS 0481, which is capped at \$11,250 for 48 months of additional obligated service. Remaining obligated service to 20 October 2020 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, Petitioner is entitled to an \$8,000 Early Reenlistment Kicker.

That part of the Petitioner's request for corrective action that exceeds the foregoing is denied.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
