1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish his correct name on his Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214). Enclosures (1) through (3) apply.
2. The Board reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 7 July 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
 - a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
 - b. Although enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to waive the statute limitation and review the application on its merits.
 - c. Petitioner enlisted in the Navy on 1 October 1979. On 10 March 1983, he received a general under honorable conditions discharge. On 24 January 1996, the county ██████████ issued Petitioner a Birth Certificate showing his name as ██████████ ██████████
 - d. At the time of Petitioner's release from active duty, he was issued a DD Form 214 which reflected his name as ██████████

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants favorable action. The Board notes that Petitioner has provided legal evidence (i.e., a Birth Certificate from the county of [REDACTED] which reflects his name as [REDACTED] to support his request, and as such, Petitioner's record should be corrected to reflect his correct name. In accordance with the foregoing, the Board concluded that the record should be corrected by the issuance of a new DD Form 214.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected to reflect his name as [REDACTED] and that a new DD Form 214, which reflects this correction, be filed in his official military personnel record.

That Petitioner be issued a new DD Form 214, which reflects his name as [REDACTED]

That no further changes be made to the record.
