Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Title 10, United States Code, Section 1552. After careful and conscientious consideration of relevant portions of your naval record and your application, the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board) found the evidence submitted insufficient to establish the existence of probable material error or injustice. Consequently, your application has been denied.

Although your application was not filed in a timely manner, the Board found it in the interest of justice to waive the statute of limitations and consider your application on its merits. A three-member panel of the Board, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 19 July 2021. The names and votes of the panel members will be furnished upon request. Your allegations of error and injustice were reviewed in accordance with administrative regulations and procedures applicable to the proceedings of the Board. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of your application together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of your naval record, applicable statutes, regulations, and policies, to include the 25 July 2018 guidance from the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness regarding equity, injustice or clemency determinations (Wilkie Memo).

You enlisted in the U.S. Navy on 22 January 1991. On 14 May 1991, you absented yourself from your unit for a period of eleven (11) hours. Subsequently, on 22 May 1991, you received non-judicial punishment (NJP) for being in an unauthorized absence (UA) status. On 16 September 1991, you absented yourself from your unit, causing you to miss a ship movement on 24 September 1991. You surrendered to the Naval Recruiting District █ on 25 September 1991 and subsequently returned to your unit on 27 September 1991. On 14 March 1993, you absented yourself from your unit, causing you to miss another ship movement on 15 March 1993. You surrendered to your unit on 1 April 1993. On 2 April 1993, you received NJP for being in a UA status and missing a ship movement. On 28 April 1993, you were given a counseling entry concerning your performance and conduct. You were further notified that you were being retained and advised that any further deficiencies in your performance or conduct would result in administrative discharge. On 31 January 1994, you received NJP for being disrespectful towards a superior commissioner officer and dereliction of duty. Subsequently, on 1
