1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting his naval record be corrected to reflect accurate last name and home of record (HOR).
2. The Board, consisting of █, █, and █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 15 February 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
  - a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
  - b. Petitioner was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 21 October 2002 to 6 January 2004 listed block 1 (Name) █, and block 7b (Home of record at time of entry) █.
  - c. Petitioner was issued a Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) for the period of 1 June 2004 to 21 June 2005 listed block 1 (Name) █ and block 7b (Home of record at time of entry) █.
  - d. On 21 October 2016, Petitioner's Record of Military Processing – Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 1966/1) listed in Section 1 block 2 (Name) █ Block 4 (Home of record address) █.

e. On 21 October 2016, Petitioner enlisted for 4 years in the U.S. Navy Reserve. Petitioner's Enlistment/Reenlistment Document Armed Forces of the United States (DD Form 4/1) listed in block A1 (Name) [REDACTED] and block A3 (Home of record) [REDACTED].

f. On 3 September 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 15 months with an Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) of 20 January 2022 in order to extend active duty. Petitioner's name was listed as [REDACTED].

g. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner's HOR is correct in the system, however, Petitioner's DD Form 4 incorrectly lists Petitioner's last name as [REDACTED].

### RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's DD Form 4 of 21 October 2016 listed in block A1 (Name) [REDACTED] vice block A1 (Name) [REDACTED].

Note: A review of Petitioner's NSIPS/ESR revealed that his home of record is [REDACTED].

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
