(2) Case Summary

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) ending with the separation date 30 May 1985 be corrected.
- 2. The Board, consisting of the property of the property of the partial corrective action indicated below should be taken. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of Petitioner's application together with all material submitted in support thereof, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. Although enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to review the application on its merits.
- c. Petitioner enlisted in the Navy and began a period of active duty on 2 June 1978. Petitioner completed this enlistment with an Honorable characterization of service on 1 June 1981, and reenlisted on 2 June 1981.
- d. Petitioner contends that his record shows a one year space between two dates; the record shows a break in service between "1981" and "1982."

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants relief in the form of correcting Block 12b of his DD Form 214. The Board noted Petitioner's DD Form 214 for the period "1 June 1982 to 30 May 1985" incorrectly cites Block 12a. The record reflects that Petitioner reenlisted into the Navy on "2 June 1981" vice "1 June 1982."

In accordance with the foregoing, the Board concluded Petitioner's effective date of enlistment for the period ending 30 May 1985 should reflect "2 June 1981" vice "1 June 1982."

RECOMMENDATION:

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action:

Petitioner be issued a DD Form 215 to show that Petitioner entered active duty for the period ending 30 May 1985 on "2 June 1981."

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's record.

That a copy of this Record of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
