1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's authorization to execute Household Goods (HHG) Personally Procured Move (PPM) with modification of BUPERS Separation Order 0251.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 October 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 7 January 2021 Petitioner orders UHAUL shipping material and rents UHAUL equipment on 20 January 2021.

b. On 20 January 2021, Petitioner is released from active duty and complete HHG PPM effective 22 January 2021.

c. On 25 January 2021, Petitioner issued BUPERS Separation Order 0251 authorizing separation during January 2021. Petitioner issued DD Form 214 on 27 January 2021 with effective date of separation of 20 January 2021.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded the Petitioner was issued Separation Orders and DD Form 214 after the effective date of his separation of 20 January 2021 warranting relief.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

BUPERS Order 0251 (Official Separation Orders) issued 1 January 2021 vice 25 January 2021. Petitioner authorized to submit Personally Procured Move (PPM) HHG.

Petitioner will submit a copy of the Board's approval letter to the Navy Household Goods Audit Team with all appropriate HHG documentation and orders to settle his claim. Settlement of move charged against Petitioner's BUPERS Order 0251.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
