Dear Petitioner:

This is in reference to your application for correction of your naval record pursuant to Section 1552 of Title 10, United States Code.

A three member panel of the Board for Correction of Naval Records, sitting in executive session, considered your application on 28 December 2021. After careful consideration, the Board concluded that your application was not timely filed, and that it would not be in the interest of justice to excuse your failure to submit your application in a timely manner. Specifically, you provided no reason for waiving the statute of limitations other than “[you] believe the false statements made against [you] have been hidden from [you] for 60 years.” The Board determined this reason was insufficient to waive the statute since there is no evidence provided that indicates you were unable to file your application within the three years from when you learned of the injustice. Of note, a preliminary review of your military records failed to reveal any reference to larceny, which you specifically addressed in your application. Consequently, your application has been denied.
