1. The enclosure was previously forwarded for your action.
2. In order to ensure proper implementation, the recommendation contained in the enclosure is hereby amended to read:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner executed a 5-year immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) on 27 July 2005 with a PEBD of 10 December 1996 and ADSD of 29 January 2001. Note: Petitioner erroneously received a zone "B" vice a zone "A" with an award level of 2.0 (\$45,000 dollar award ceiling) for the IT rate. Remaining obligated service to 29 July 2005 will be deducted from SRB computation.

Petitioner executed a 5-year immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) on 4 February 2010 with a PEBD of 10 December 1996 and ADSD of 29 January 2001. Note: Petitioner erroneously received a zone "C" vice a zone "B" SRB with an award level of 4.0 (\$60,000 dollar award ceiling) for the ND/5342 (M1DV) rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 26 July 2010 will be deducted from SRB computation.

Petitioner executed a 4-year immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601) on 4 November 2013 with a PEBD of 10 December 1996 and ADSD of 29 January 2001. Note: Petitioner is entitled to a zone "C" SRB with an award level of 2.0 (\$60,000 dollar award ceiling) for the ND/5342 (M1DV) rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 3 February 2015 will be deducted from SRB computation.

Note: Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) will complete an audit of Petitioner's records to determine if Petitioner is due any back pay. Recalculation of the SRB's by DFAS is necessary.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

3. The regulations approved by the Secretary of the Navy require that the naval record of Petitioner be corrected, where appropriate, per the approved recommendation of the Board.
