1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner signed an administrative remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) vice an agreement to extend enlistment for 6 months in order to meet the required OBLISERVE.

2. The Board, consisting of ██████████, ██████████, and ██████████, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 December 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 23 May 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 22 May 2022 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) of 22 May 2024. Petitioner was guaranteed Advanced Technical Field Special Warfare Operator (ATF/SO 6YO) Challenge Program.

c. On 27 January 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: ██████████) with a required obligated service to November 2024. Petitioner's ultimate activity was ██████████ for duty. Furthermore, circumstances such as potential monetary loss under critical skills bonus or SRB, refer to MILPERSMAN 1306-106 para 4. Use of NAVPERS 1070/613 only authorized for Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) eligible sailors use of

NAVPERS 1070/613 for periods of more than 12 months require NAVPERSCOM (BUPERS-[REDACTED]) authorization.

d. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was authorized to meet the required OBLISERV by signing an NAVPERS 1070/613 in lieu of a 6-month extension of enlistment to prevent monetary loss of SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The 6-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) operative on 23 May 2024 is removed.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 27 January 2020; fulfilling a 6 month agreement to extend enlistment operative on 23 May 2024. Note: This will establish a SEAOS of 22 May 2024

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
