



evidence. Based on the available evidence, the Board concluded there was insufficient evidence of an error or injustice to warrant removing the NJP from your record. As your NJP was not removed, the Board further concluded the additional relief you requested –corrections to your dates of rank, remedial promotion to staff sergeant, and back pay and allowances -- should also be denied.

You are entitled to have the Board reconsider its decision upon submission of new matters, which will require you to complete and submit a new DD Form 149. New matters are those not previously presented to or considered by the Board. In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that a presumption of regularity attaches to all official records. Consequently, when applying for a correction of an official naval record, the burden is on the applicant to demonstrate the existence of probable material error or injustice.
