Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB) and Early Reenlistment Kicker.
- 2. The Board, consisting of and and reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 December 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
 - b. On 12 December 2011, Petitioner entered active duty.
- c. On 3 February 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an End of Current Contract (ECC) of 2 February 2021 and End of Active Service (EAS) of 2 June 2023.
 - d. On 1 March 2020, Petitioner was promoted to Staff Sergeant/E-6.
- e. On 20 April 2020, Petitioner was issued Modification Marine Corps Basic Order for involuntary assignment to M.C. Communication Electronics School (Student),

for career progression training within the 28XX occupational field, PMOS 2862. Report no later than 31 August 2020.

f. In accordance with reference (b), this bulletin announces the SRB program and the Broken Service SRB (BSSRB) program authorized for FY21. With 1the advent of several new SRB programs, Marines are encouraged to thoroughly review the contents of this bulletin. First term Marines (Zone A) and career Marines (Zone B, C, D, and E) who reenlist on or after 7 July 2020 are eligible for the FY21 SRB program. This will include any regular component first term or career Marine with an ECC from 1 October 2020 to 30 September 2021.

Marines in Zones A, B, and C who submit for a 48 month reenlistment between 7 July 2020 through 30 September 2020 with a PMOS that is listed in section(s) 3.1, 3.m, and 3.n, and are subsequently approved, will rate an 8,000 dollar Early Reenlistment Kicker in addition to the Primary Military Occupational Specialties (PMOS) bonus amount listed in section(s) 3.1, 3.m, and 3.n. After 30 September 2020, this Early Reenlistment Kicker will expire.

Zone B applies to those active component Marines with 6 to 10 years of active military service. Zone B PMOS bonus payments for Marines who reenlist for at least 48 months obligated service are authorized as listed below in dollars (bonuses for Marines who reenlist for 36 to 47 months obligated service will be calculated as per para 3.i). Furthermore, a zone "B" SRB for MOS 2862, E-6 and above, which is capped at \$14,000 for 48 months of additional obligated service was authorized.

- g. On 11 August 2020, Petitioner's Careerist Active Duty Reenlistment request was submitted, and approved by HQMC on 9 January 2021. Petitioner's PMOS was 2841.
 - h. On 23 January 2021, Petitioner reenlisted for 4 years with an ECC of 22 January 2025.
- i. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that at the time of submission on 11 August 2020 Petitioner held the PMOS of 2841 making him ineligible to receive the Zone B SRB. Petitioner has since graduated from the Electronics Maintenance Technician course on 28 June 2021 and was awarded the PMOS of 2862. He is now eligible for the FY21 Zone B SRB and Early Reenlistment Kicker.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

The enlistment/reenlistment document (DD Form 4) executed on 23 January 2021 was for a term of 4 years and 1 month, vice 4 years.

Note: This change, upon completion of MOS training, will entitle the member to a zone "B" SRB for MOS 2862, which is capped at \$14,000 for 48 months of additional obligated service. Remaining obligated service to 2 February 2021 will be deducted from SRB computation. Furthermore, Petitioner is entitled to receive the \$8,000 Early Reenlistment Kicker.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
