Subj: REVIEW OF NAVAL RECORD ICO

1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting his naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 26 October 2021 and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of **Sector 14** December 2021 and **Sector 14** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 14 December 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 16 January 2014, Petitioner entered active duty.

c. On 27 October 2017, Petitioner reenlisted for 6 years with an EAOS of 26 October 2021.

d. On 3 August 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2160) with a required obligated service to November 2023, while stationed in with an effective date of departure of November 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was for duty with an effective date of arrival of 30 June 2021.

e. On 28 September 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 24 months with an SEAOS of 26 October 2023 in order to incur obligated service to execute BUPERS Order 2160 dated 3 August 2020 in accordance with MILPERSMAN 1160-040.

f. On 12 November 2020, Petitioner was issued official modification to change duty orders (BUPERS order: 2160) while stationed in **Example 1** with an effective date of departure of February 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was **Example 2** for duty with an effective date of arrival of 15 October 2021.

g. In accordance with reference (d) [9 August 2021], FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21) listed a zone "B" SRB with an award level of 2.0 (\$45,000 award ceiling) for the IT/H09A rate/NEC.

h. On 5 October 2021, Petitioner signed a Command Career Request (NPPSC 1160/1) for a 6 year reenlistment effective 26 October 2021, and was approved by cognizant authority on 11 November 2021.

i. On 25 October 2021, Petitioner earned NEC H09A (CANES AN/USQ-208(V) System Administrator/Maintainer).

j. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that Petitioner was approved to reenlist for SRB for 6 years on 26 October 2021. However, the Personnel Support Detachment was unable to create the reenlistment contract prior to the scheduled reenlistment date. This delay allowed for an inoperative 24-month extension of enlistment to go operative resulting in him being ineligible to reenlist for SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner was discharged on 25 October 2021 and reenlisted on 26 October 2021 for a term of 6 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "B" SRB with an award level of 2.0 (\$45,000 award ceiling) for the IT/H09A rate/NEC.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
