1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting her naval record be corrected to show Petitioner reenlisted on 20 September 2021 vice 19 June 2020 and was eligible for and received a Selective Reenlistment Bonus (SRB).

2. The Board, consisting of █, █, and █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 21 December 2021 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 15 October 2018, Petitioner entered active duty for 4 years with an End of Active Obligated Service (EAOS) of 14 October 2022 and Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) of 14 October 2023.

c. On 2 January 2020, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0020) with a required obligated service to July 2025, while stationed in █ with an effective date of departure of June 2020. Petitioner's ultimate activity was █, █ for duty – under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 20 July 2020.

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d. On 30 April 2020, Petitioner submitted an Electronic Personnel Action Request (NAVPERS 1306/7) requesting STAR program reenlistment, and was approved by cognizant authority on 30 April 2020.

e. On 19 June 2020, Petitioner reenlisted for 5 years with an EAOS of 18 June 2025.

f. In accordance with reference (b), a Rating/NEC HM/ L31A (Medical Laboratory Technician) with and obliserv of 5 years was listed with the following notes: MPM 1160-100 outlines the OBLISERV requirements for STAR program reenlistment.

g. On 1 July 2020, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED].

h. On 13 August 2020, Petitioner signed an agreement to extend enlistment for 1 month with an SEAOS of 18 July 2025 in order to extend to incur sufficient obligated service to execute BUPERS order 0020 dated 28 January 2020.

i. On 2 March 2021, Petitioner was issued official change duty orders (BUPERS order: 0611), while stationed in Fort [REDACTED] with an effective date of departure of March 2021. Petitioner's ultimate activity was [REDACTED] for duty – under instruction with an effective date of arrival of 9 March 2021.

j. On 29 March 2021, Deputy Chief of Naval Personnel notified Petitioner that she was authorized immediate in-rate reenlistment in the Active Component (AC) with an end date of July 2022.

k. In accordance with reference (c), FY21 SRB Award Plan (N13SRB 005/FY21) listed a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 2.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the HM/L31A rate/NEC.

l. On 20 September 2021, Petitioner transferred from [REDACTED]. Petitioner earned NEC L31A.

m. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded that BUPERS order: 0020 required Petitioner to obligate service out to July 2025. To prevent potential monetary loss of SRB, BUPERS-328 may authorize the use of NAVPERS 1070/613 for periods of more than 12 months of OBLISERV instead of executing a reenlistment contract. The CCC should have requested authorization from BUPERS-328 to place 21 months of extension on an Administrative Remarks - NAVPERS 1070/613. Upon completion of Medical Laboratory Technician School and earning Navy

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Enlisted Classification (NEC) L31A on 20 September 2021, Petitioner could then reenlist for 5 years and be awarded a zone "A" SRB.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner's 1-month agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621) executed on 13 August 2020 is cancelled.

Petitioner executed an Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) on 19 June 2020 fulfilling a 21-month agreement to extend enlistment operative on 15 October 2023.

Petitioner was discharged and reenlisted on 19/20 September 2021, vice on 18/19 June 2020 for a term of 5 years.

Note: This change will entitle the member to a zone "A" SRB with an award level of 2.0 (\$30,000 award ceiling) for the HM/L31A rate/NEC. Remaining obligated service to 14 October 2022 will be deducted from SRB computation.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)) and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of reference (a), has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
