- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) to reflect 14 months sea service time in Block 12g.
- 2. The Board, consisting of property, and previewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 10 February 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:
- a. On 19 December 1980 Petitioner signs issued Administrative Remarks (NAVPERS 1070/613) from witnessed signature reflecting the following: "Date: 80DEC19 TOTAL CUMLATIVE SEA DUTY AS OF 80DEC19 DETERMINED TO BE 01 YEARS 04 MONTHS." This NAVPERS 1070/613 is resident in Petitioner's Official Military Personnel File (OMPF).
- b. On 12 June 1981 Petitioner released from active duty and transferred to Navy Reserve. Petitioner issued DD Form 214, block 12g (Sea Service) reflects 00 years, 05 months, and 25 days.

## **CONCLUSION**

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded based on documents contained in Petitioner's OMPF the sea service reflected on DD Form 214 effective 12 June 1981 is not correct, warranting partial relief.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Issue Petitioner DD Form 215 correcting DD Form 214 issued effective 12 June 1981.

Block 12g (Sea Service) is 01 years, 04 months, and 00 days vice 00 years, 05 months, 25 days.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

- 4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.
- 5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
