1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) section 12 "Record of Service" specifically 12a, 12c, and 12e.

2. The Board, consisting of **Construction**, **Construction**, and **Construction** reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 17 February 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 17 May 2003 Petitioner appointed 2NDLT in USMCR after completion of NROTC program.

b. On 12 June 2003 Petitioner enters active duty. Petitioner's Armed Forces Active Duty Base Date (AFADBD) and Pay Entry Base Date (PEBD) are effective this date.

c. On 1 September 2007 Petitioner is appointed a Captain effective this date.

d. On 27 May 2009, without any evidence of previous active duty separation, Petitioner's resignation for Intradepartmental Transfer is effective. DD Form 214 issued. Block 12a (Date Entered AD this Period) 2005 05 01; Block 12b (Separation Date This Period) 2009 05 27; Block 12c (Net Active Service this Period) 04 years, 00 months, 27 Days; Block 12d (Total Prior Active Service) 00 years, 00 months, 00 days; Block 12e (Total Prior Inactive Service) 01 years, 10 months,

19 days. Petitioner's Official Military Personnel File (OMPF) does not contain any other DD Form 214s or separation documents.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded the Petitioner's record reflects he entered active duty in the U.S. Marine Corps on 12 June 2003 and remained in an active duty status through 27 May 2009, warranting relief.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner issued DD Form 215 correcting DD Form 214 issued effective 27 May 2009 for appropriate distribution the following corrections:

Block 12a. "2003 06 12" vice "2005 05 01" Block 12c. "05 11 16" vice "04 00 27" Block 12e. "00 00 25" vice "01 10 19"

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
