1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that her naval record be corrected to establish Petitioner's authorization for Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) at dependent location █, █ for the period between 4 December 2017 through 15 July 2021 per references (b) and (c).

2. The Board, consisting of █ reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 19 May 2022 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of Petitioner's naval record, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, found that, before applying to this Board, he exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy. The Board made the following findings:

a. On 4 December 2017 Petitioner joined for duty with █. Per Petitioner's Master Military Pay Account she begin receiving BAH at dependent child location █ effective this date.

b. On 11 December 2019 Petitioner transferred from █, █ and joined for duty with Permanent Duty Station (PDS), █ effective 11 January 2020. On date of join Petitioner's BAH at dependent rate was changed to new PDS zip code 32228. The █ homeport change to █ was effective 1 April 2020. Petitioner's MMPA does not reflect a housing allowance change to Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA). Petitioner continued to receive BAH at █ from 11 January 2020 through 15 July 2021.

c. On 16 July 2021 Petitioner's BAH was changed to dependent location zip code █

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2)<sup>1</sup>, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board determined based on Petitioner's MMPA payment of BAH at dependent zip code [REDACTED] was paid for the period of 4 December 2017 through 10 January 2020, therefore, concluded only partial relief is warranted for BAH at dependent location zip code [REDACTED] for the period of 11 January 2020 through 15 July 2021.

RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner receive BAH Credit at dependent rate for zip code [REDACTED] for the period of 11 January 2020 through 15 July 2021.

That no further changes be made to Petitioner's naval record.

That a copy of this report of proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above-entitled matter.

5. Pursuant to the delegation of authority set out in Section 6(e) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(e)), and having assured compliance with its provisions, it is hereby announced that the foregoing corrective action, taken under the authority of the reference, has been approved by the Board on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy.
