1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with the Board for Correction of Naval Records (Board), requesting that his naval record be corrected to remove an Administrative Remarks (Page 11) 6105 counseling entry and associated rebuttal.

2. The Board, consisting of [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED], reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 16 May 2022, and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, relevant portions of the naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations, and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. On 25 August 2021, Petitioner was issued a Page 11 6105 for failure to report an inappropriate relationship between a Marine Officer and Staff non-commissioned officer. Petitioner acknowledged the entry and submitted a written rebuttal. See enclosure (2).

c. On 10 January 2022, Petitioner's Commanding Officer, and the individual who issued the Page 11 6105, provided a letter of endorsement to Petitioner's application requesting removal of the counseling.

CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting relief. In this regard, the Board concluded enclosure (2), the contested Page 11 6105 and rebuttal, shall be removed from Petitioner's official military personnel file. The Board relied on the CO's endorsement letter to find that the inclusion of the Page 11 6105 was no longer warranted.

RECOMMENDATION

In view of the above, the Board directs the following corrective action.

Petitioner's naval record be corrected by removing enclosure (2), his 25 August 2021 Page 11 6105 counseling entry and 31 August 2021 rebuttal.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
