- g. Petitioner transferred to the Fleet Reserve effective 1 September 2021 and automatically enrolled in SBP Spouse coverage.
- h. On 26 March 2022, Petitioner and spouse signed SBP Affidavit before a notary witness requesting to decline SBP coverage.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action. The Board concluded Petitioner provided sufficient evidence to reflect her and spouse's desire to decline SBP coverage. Although the proper administrative requirements were not completed, the Board felt that under these circumstances, relief is warranted.

## RECOMMENDATION

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

Petitioner elected to decline participation in SBP with spouse concurrence prior to transferring to the Fleet Reserve effective 1 September 2021.

Note: Defense Finance and Accounting Service will complete an audit of Petitioner's pay records to determine the amount of premium refund.

A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
